Subject: Deletion of names of Dead Elector from Electoral Roll_regarding.

This office has received a D.O. letter dated 8th May, 2018 from Deputy Election Commissioner, Election Commission of India vide which the matter of sharing of the data on registered deaths on a monthly basis in order to remove the dead electors from the Electoral Roll has been raised.

- 2. You may be aware that the above matter was taken up by this office during 2003 & 2004 with all the State Governments with the request to take appropriate action under Rule 9 of the Registration of Electoral Rules, 1960, where it is obligatory on the part of Registrar of births and deaths to furnish the information related to dead voters to the concerned Electoral Registration Officer at least twice in a year. A reminder in this regard was also issued by this office on 27th April 2004 and 24th May, 2007 to all States/UT's.
- 3. In light of the above, you are requested to issue necessary directions to all the District Registrar's and local Registrar's of births and deaths of your State in respect of the referred matter and ensure that the information on relevant data fields from the death register be sent to the concerned Electoral registration Officer by the Registrar of births and deaths. The action taken in this regard may kindly be intimated to this office.
